#### **SCRIPTURE**

#### Exodus 13:17 – 15:21 (from The Peace Table Bible)

God led the Israelites out of Egypt, through the wilderness, and toward the Red Sea. God went in front of them in a pillar of cloud by day. At night, God lighted their way in a pillar of fire.

When Pharaoh and his army drew close, the Israelites looked back in terror. They cried out to Moses, "Why did you bring us out of Egypt to die? It would have been better to work as slaves than to die in the wilderness."

Moses said, "Do not be afraid. Be still and see what God will do."
