#### Isaiah 40:1-5

40 Comfort, comfort my people! says your God.
<sup>2</sup> Speak compassionately to Jerusalem, and proclaim to her that her compulsory service has ended, that her penalty has been paid, that she has received from the LORD's hand double for all her sins!

<sup>3</sup> A voice is crying out:
"Clear the LORD's way in the desert! Make a level highway in the wilderness for our God!
<sup>4</sup> Every valley will be raised up, and every mountain and hill will be flattened. Uneven ground will become level, and rough terrain a valley plain.
<sup>5</sup> The LORD's glory will appear,

and all humanity will see it together; the LORD's mouth has commanded it."

## Luke 3:1-6

**3** In the fifteenth year of the rule of the emperor Tiberius—when Pontius Pilate was governor over Judea and Herod was ruler<sup>[a]</sup> over Galilee, his brother Philip was ruler<sup>[b]</sup> over Ituraea and Trachonitis, and Lysanias was ruler<sup>[c]</sup> over Abilene, <sup>2</sup> during the high priesthood of Annas and Caiaphas—God's word came to John son of Zechariah in the wilderness. <sup>3</sup> John went throughout the region of the Jordan River, calling for people to be baptized to show that they were changing their hearts and lives and wanted God to forgive their sins. <sup>4</sup> This is just as it was written in the scroll of the words of Isaiah the prophet,

A voice crying out in the wilderness: "Prepare the way for the Lord; make his paths straight.
<sup>5</sup> Every valley will be filled, and every mountain and hill will be leveled.
The crooked will be made straight and the rough places made smooth.
<sup>6</sup> All humanity will see God's salvation."


